NCATS PHARMACEUTICAL COLLECTION

The NCATS Pharmaceutical Collection (NPC) is a storehouse of approved drugs. Scientists use the collection to identify potential ways to repurpose drugs for new uses.

Over the past **10 YEARS**, researchers used the **NPC** to study an array of pathways and disease models, generating an unparalleled amount of data.

A number of projects produced drugs with new potential uses that have entered clinical trials, or have shown activity in testing, for several diseases and viruses.

The NPC contains nearly **3,000** small molecule drugs. More than **300** requests for collaborations to screen the NPC resulted in **200+** collaborative Ebola virus projects in such areas as rare and neglected diseases, infectious diseases and cancer.
